- Annotation of article (up to 200 words).

Until **April 22, 2015, 10:00** participants should submit:

- Full text of the paper (4-6 p.);
- Abstracts (1 p.).

Conference language: Latvian. Each student may apply for not more than 2 articles. The conference abstracts will be published in the annual materials of RTU Student Scientific and Technical Conference.

Conference proceedings will be published in Institute of Applied Computer Systems students scientific papers "Applied Computer Systems".

The best papers will be awarded in the conference plenary.
